Difficult words:

- ▶ **Discriminate or discrimination** means: Treating or disadvantaging someone unfairly.
- ▶ **Racism is** when someone is treated unfairly, because they are perceived to be different. For example, because they look different or come from another country or have a different faith.
- ▶ **Courage** means bravery. This is pronounced: kuh-radsch.

I'm doing this voluntarily. Nobody forced me to do it. I sign and commit myself to:

1. In our school, everyone should be treated **equally fairly**. Now and in the future. Nobody should be treated worse or disadvantaged. **I stand up for this!**
2. If I witness violence, insults, or mistreatment: **Then I speak up against it**. And I tell my trusted teacher. **I show courage!**
3. Our school must do something **against unfair treatment, insults, and violence**. Now and in the future. **At least once a year**, our school must undertake a project on this. **I will help with that!**
